

3. Do I put my name on my project?

Answer: No, your name will go on a piece of masking tape on the back of your board along with your class period. You can do this when you bring it to class. Also, if you are using photos on your board, make sure they don't have anyone's face showing. There shouldn't be any identifying information anywhere on your board.

4. Do I attach the log to my project board?

Answer: No, your log will be handed in to me just before you present your project in class. If the project meets the minimum requirements to go to the fair, then I will help you attach the log.

5. Do I have to have three trials?

Answer? Yes, to receive full credit for that portion of your grade you should have three trials. The data table should show the results of all three of your trials. If you are showing your results with a graph, make sure you also include the data table in which you recorded your original information. In some cases, it is too expensive and or time consuming to do three trials. This is certainly understandable, however, a few points will be deducted.

6. Are pictures required?

Answer? No, not necessarily. You can bring in any form of proof that you like. Most students prefer pictures because it is easy to bring to school. However, many students bring in
