8. Can I work with a partner?

9. Is the project a requirement?

Answer: Yes, each sixth grade student is required to do a science project at home. It does not have to go to the fair but it does need to be presented in class. The project is worth four grades. (presentation, display board, experimental design, and bibliography and log) There is a copy of the grade sheet in your packet.

10. If my project goes to the science fair, do I need to present it to the judges?

Answer: No, your project board, log, and any display you might have will go to the library. You do not need to be there. That is one reason why your log should have everything you did or tried written in it. The more detailed your log the better.
